Dear Parents and Students: Please read the following carefully as there is important information and dates for the 2023 Recital. Thank you.

IMPORTANT NOTES:

- All accounts must be at \$0.00 before the recital date. This includes all recital fees, costume fees, & monthly. Your child will not be allowed to participate in the recital if all fees aren't paid. Thank you.
- **We will NOT be holding classes on Memorial Day, May 30th, May 31st or June 1st. The week of May 22nd will be our last week of classes.**

ALL team dances will be performing in the Team Showcase on Friday evening at 5:30pm.

DRESS REHEARSAL- All dancers performing in the recital are required to attend their scheduled dress rehearsal.

All dancers will participate in a dress rehearsal. We will be rehearsing recreational dances only, not team dances. Please check the attached rehearsal schedule carefully to see what time you will rehearse. All classes will be assigned a specific time to rehearse your dance on the stage. Please arrive 20 minutes before your scheduled rehearsal time in costume, tights and proper dance shoes. We are working on a tight schedule, and will do our best to remain prompt but will need your help in having your child arrive early, dressed and ready. You and your student are free to leave after you are finished rehearsing.

Bring all costumes to dress rehearsal. Wear your hair and make-up the way you intend to wear it for the recital. Mothers and /or fathers are welcome at the rehearsal. In an effort to hold down confusion and noise, we ask that you please not bring other family members or friends. You will be free to leave after done rehearsing your dance(s). Remember, no food, candy, or drinks inside the auditorium. Check the schedule to see which dance you are doing first if you have multiple dances and be sure to know the order of your dances.

Note: At dress rehearsal only, dancers can watch the show from the auditorium in costume but must be dressed and ready to line up when called to the stage. Please sit while in auditorium. Some dancers will have too many costume changes to watch from the auditorium.

Curtain Call Rehearsal (ALL DANCERS):

At the end of the show all students will return to the stage before the final curtain call. **We will practice this first on THURSDAY during dress rehearsal.** During the recital, all dancers must be back stages before the final number to be ready for curtain call. **PLEASE STAY IN YOUR LAST COSTUME FOR CURTAIN CALL DURING THE RECITAL ON SATURDAY.**

Day of the Show:

NO COSTUMES WILL BE ALLOWED IN THE AUDIENCE THE DAY OF THE SHOW! Students not in Act I for the afternoon show may sit in the audience with their parents in street clothes and tights until Intermission when each mother is responsible to bring them backstage and dress them for Act II. All students are to remain backstage for the rest of the show in costume so they can participate in the final curtain call.

COSTUMES, HAIR, MAKEUP: Be sure to bring all costumes to dress rehearsal and recital. They should be steamed if needed. Shoes and tights should be the ones ordered with your recital costume. Have your name on all costume parts, shoes, tights. Etc. Do not wear jewelry, colored nail or toe polish on stage. **DO NOT WEAR UNDERWEAR BENEATH YOUR COSTUME.** Your hair should be fixed to stay out of your face (bun or pony-tail) and you should have enough bobby pins to secure your headpiece (please see attached hair sheet for information). Makeup is needed-including eye shadow, red or pink lipstick depending on costume color, blush and mascara. Competition dancers wear false eyelashes. Mothers are expected to dress their child in the proper costume and go back to change costume and shoes if your child is in more than one number. Please return to your seat after your child is ready.

AFTER YOUR CHILD DANCES: Dancers will remain backstage in costume so they can participate in the final curtain call. Parents need to come backstage to pick up their children at the after the final curtain call. We have many Backstage Moms who will be helping keep the little ones together & entertained. Please bring snacks or something for them to do such as coloring while they wait in the dressing rooms. Guests please wait until after the show to greet and congratulate dancers. Only females will be allowed in the backstage area, as the girls will be changing costumes.

TICKET INFORMATION:

All tickets this year will be purchased online. Please tell this to all of your family & friends who will be attending. This is where you will order and pay for each ticket. **WE WILL NOT BE SELLING TICKETS AT THE DOOR.**

If you are mom HELPING & not planning on sitting in the audience for a long period of time, you do not need to purchase a ticket.

Everyone who will be in the audience will need a ticket. If you are a parents with a child in SHOW #1 that has to perform twice, you are more than welcome to stay back stage during one of those shows.

Tickets will go on sale on May 1st. for \$12 Again, no tickets will be sold at the studio and we will NOT be selling tickets at the door. To order tickets, you need to go to the following link:

It is also particularly important you select the correct show you are wanting to purchase a ticket for, as there are 4 shows listed. Please see the list on the first page of what classes are in each viewing.

Your child will not be able to participate in the show unless all past due tuition and show fee have been paid.

Other Important Information:

PHOTOGRAPHS: Lauren will be taking class photos this year at the dance studio. Picture week will be May 15-18. Please see the attached photo schedule. The \$30 package is geared towards students who are in 1 classes/routines and the \$45 package is geared towards students who are in 2 or more classes/routines. If you want to purchase a photo package you may do so on our website under the “Recital Information” tab. Price is per student. Each student will receive a USB with their child’s pictures on it. You must pay for them before your child is photographed. Although you are not required to order photos, we would like everyone from PDC classes there to be present for the class photos. Photos may be ready by dress rehearsal night, otherwise **YOU WILL PICKUP THE PHOTORAPHS AT THE SUTDIO WHEN THEY ARE READY.** Come dressed in the proper costume, hair fixed and make-up on. The schedule will also be posted on the bulletin board and on the door. Please be prompt as the photographer will be working on a tight schedule and will not wait. There will be no dance classes May 15-18 due to pictures. You will only need to come at your classes assigned picture time.

DANCE TEAM PICTURE: We will take the Competition Team picture on **WEDNESDAY** May 17th (See schedule below). Hair needs to be up in a ponytail away from the face. Please wear your team jacket, black pants, and put it on over your purple team shirt. **WEAR BLACK JAZZ SHOES, BLACK SOCKS, OR BLACK TENNIS SHOES.**

RECITAL PROGRAM ADS: We will again be offering display ads and happy ads for sale in our Souvenir Picture Program for Project Dance Company’s 10th annual dance production. The proceeds of the sale of the ads help to pay for the printing of the lovely picture program. You might consider dedicating a page to your shining star with a beautiful picture of her/him with a special message & picture to congratulate them on a year of hard work.

Also, a great idea is to have your student photographed with a friend or with their classmates/teammates and divide the cost among all members. In this case you may use group pictures taken during the year at class or at competitions. Local businesses may also purchase advertisements in the program. Happy ads (text only) will also be available and are a nice way for parents to support their children and for students to support their friends. (limit 25 words).

Purchasing an ad for your dancer in our 10th annual Souvenir Picture Program is a great way to show support for your dancer or dancers. Our performance will play to an audience of nearly 1000 on the weekend of June 3rd, 2023. Supporting our free program is a great way to show your support to the dancers of the Macomb and surrounding communities.

DISTRIBUTION OF COSTUMES: Costumes are being passed out as they come in. There is a sheet with specific instructions in each class as to how to wear costume and what needs be done. In order to maintain optimal instructional time, there will be no costume explanation at costume distribution, so please read and follow all detailed instructions with each costume. If your costume come with tights, **PLEASE DO NOT USE THE TIGHTS BEFORE RECITAL.**

RECITAL TSHIRTS: Everyone is more than welcome to purchase a recital t-shirt. Purchases can be made through our website under the “Recital Information” tab. All of the students names will be on the back. Shirts will be distributed once they come in. Shirts are \$30. Deadline is **APRIL 21st.**

DVDs: Please show consideration for dancers and audience by not taking videos the day or night of recital. This year we have TNT Video Services to video our performance. DVDs are \$25. You may purchase these online through our website under the “Recital Information” tab. If you chose to wait until recital day payments must be made out to TNT VIDEO SERVICES. Forms will also be available on recital day. **YOU WILL PICK UP YOUR VIDEO AT PROJECT DANCE COMPANY WHEN THEY ARE READY. NO VIDEO OR FLASH PHOTOGRAPHY WILL BE ALLOWED IN THE AUDITORIUM DURING THE RECITAL.**
